To employees—Shorter University employees are encouraged to see their personal primary care physicians whenever ill or injured, but occasionally an employee may need the services of SHS during the office hours. In such a situation, if there is a charge applied (see above), an employee is asked to pay for any services rendered either with cash or check made payable to Shorter University. Employees are discouraged from visiting campus doctors on Wednesday afternoons as the physicians' time is limited to 2 hours for the students. Employees of the University, Aramark, and National may use the self-care center for over-the-counter medications that are available for check-out at no charge. Appropriate forms must be completed and signed in order that services may be rendered to students and/or staff, as appropriate.
