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Tax Information—Use 2020 Taxes We highly encourage you (and your spouse or parents) to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool on your FAFSA to transfer Federal tax information directly from the IRS to your FAFSA. The best way to verify tax information is to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool at www.fafsa.gov. In a few steps, you may be able to view your tax return information and transfer it directly into your FAFSA.

*If you choose not to use the IRS tool or if you are not eligible to use the IRS tool, you **MUST** submit an IRS Federal Tax Return Transcript (not an Account Transcript) for 2020. To request a free Federal Tax Return Transcript, you may:*

3. Visit a IRS Office near you (an appointment may be required)

Family Information – Check One

You are considered Dependent if you were required to provide parental information on your FAFSA.

- Your spouse, if married,
- Your children,
- Other people IF you or your spouse will provide more than half of their support from July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023.

If anyone listed will be enrolled at least half-time in a degree or certificate program between July 1, 2022 and June 30, 2023, please include the name of the college they will be attending.
